At Lord I have cried: Triodion; *Glory: Standing before the tomb...; Both now: Having completed...*

Prokimenon, Tone 6: Genesis 49: 33 – 50: 26

Prokimenon, Tone 4: Proverbs 31: 8–31

Let my prayer be set forth... and the rest of the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts

Great Compline

After the first Trisagion: *In confirming the common resurrection...*

After the second Trisagion: *Have mercy on us, O Lord...*

After the Doxology: Canon in the Triodion

After the Trisagion, Kontakion: *Christ, the Joy of all...*

The lesser dismissal is used

Matins

After *God is the Lord: In confirming the common resurrection...*, thrice

After the first Kathisma: Sessional Hymn from the Triodion, twice

After the second Kathisma: Evlogitaria of the Resurrection

Small litany and Sessional Hymn: *O Fountain of Wisdom...*

Having beheld the Resurrection; Psalm 50;

Canon

Odes 1 – 5

Two canons 8 *Glory to Thee, our God, glory to Thee*

Odes 6 – 9

Four-canticle canons 6 *Glory to Thee, our God, glory to Thee*

Katavasia *Having crossed the water as though it were dry land...*

After Ode 3: Sessional Hymns in the Triodion (III)

After Ode 6: Kontakion and Ikos of Lazarus Saturday (VI)

After Ode 8: We do not sing *My soul doth magnify...*

Holy is the Lord, our God

Exapostilaria: *At Thy word...* twice; *Glory, Both now: Through Lazarus, O death...*

Praises: Lazarus 8; *Glory: A great and marvelous wonder...; Both now: Most blessed art thou...*
