Hypakoï in the tone of the week; Sessional hymns of the Saint

Hymns of Ascent and Prokimenon in the tone of the week

4th Matins Gospel

Having beheld the Resurrection

Psalm 50

Glory: Through the prayers of the Apostles..., Both now: Through the prayers of the Theotokos..., Have mercy on me, O God..., Jesus having risen...
