Cross & Resurrection 1 *Glory to Thy precious Cross and Resurrection, O Lord*

Theotokos 1 *O Most Holy Theotokos, save us*

Martyrs 4 *O holy martyrs, pray to God for us*

Katavasia *I will open my mouth*
