At Lord I have cried: Octoechos 7; Triodion 3 (first repeated); Glory: Triodion (Almighty Lord...) Both now: Dogmatic Theotokion in the tone of the week

Aposticha: Octoechos; Glory: Triodion (Mine eyes are weighed down...); Both now: Resurrectional Theotokion, Tone 5

Troparia: O Theotokos Virgin, Rejoice, thrice

Matins

After God is the Lord: Resurrectional Troparion, twice; Glory, Both now: Dismissal Theotokion, in the tone of the week

After each Kathisma: Sessional Hymns from the Octoechos

Evlogitaria

Hypakoë, Hymns of Ascent and Prokeimenon in tone of the week

1st Matins Gospel

Having beheld the Resurrection; Psalm 50

Glory: The doors of repentance; Both now: Guide me in the paths of salvation; Have mercy on me, O God; When I think of the multitude of evil things I have done
